The AMRS will be having a work session on July 22nd at David Petersen place instead of the regular meeting. If you are interested in joining the group, email George Zapalac for more information.





Shelf Layout Project


The first iteration of the track plan was displayed at the meeting. It should be on the division website shortly. Here are some photos of the track plan. Blue is the mainline.




The entire track plan.




The left side.

Steve Jakobs earned the Master Model Railroader Achievement Certificate for Author.




Robert Theile earned the Master Model Railroader Achievement Certificates for Association Volunteer & Association Official.

Joel Davidson brought a 3D printed wifi Steam throttle. Here is the link for more information.


