
Let's Build-A-Layout Project







Helpful Hint

I am going to pass along a helpful hint that I learned from Airfix Model World Magazine. While it is easy to scribe styrene in straight flat lines, scribing a curved surface is a lot harder. The author of the article recommended using plastic labeling tape (AKA Dymo Labeler). It gives a sharp well defined edge and it will bend to fit a curved surface. It also has an adhesive surface so that it will stick to the plastic.


