Tim Giraud's Sculptamold Recipe

The mix is 1-part sculptamold to 2-parts paper mâché, and enough acrylic paint to tint to your desired color, then add enough water to mix to the consistency of oatmeal. You can also use 3-parts paper mâché if you want a longer working time, such as when you are mixing a larger quantity to do a larger area, just know that will take a longer time to dry out. The 2-part mix will take approximately 24 to 48 hours to dry completely, and the 3-part mix will take about an additional 12 hours. If you have a fan blowing on the area it will slightly reduce the drying time. The drying time is determined by how thick you apply the sculptamold.


